

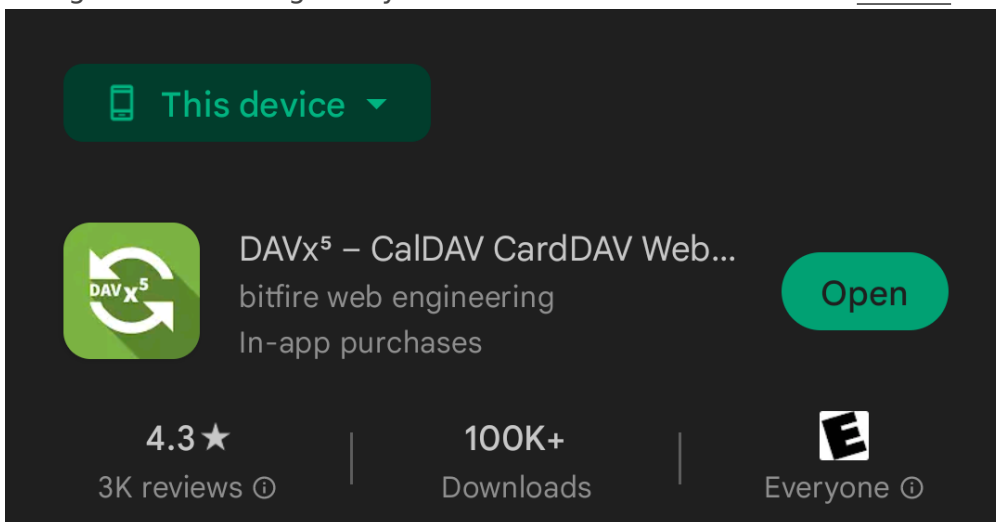
Connecting to a Baïkal Calendar in Android

Instructions

Installing the Required Apps

Install DAVx⁵

1. Navigate to the Google Play Store and search for and install DAVx5.



Link the Baïkal with DAVx⁵

1. Select "Login with URL and user name".

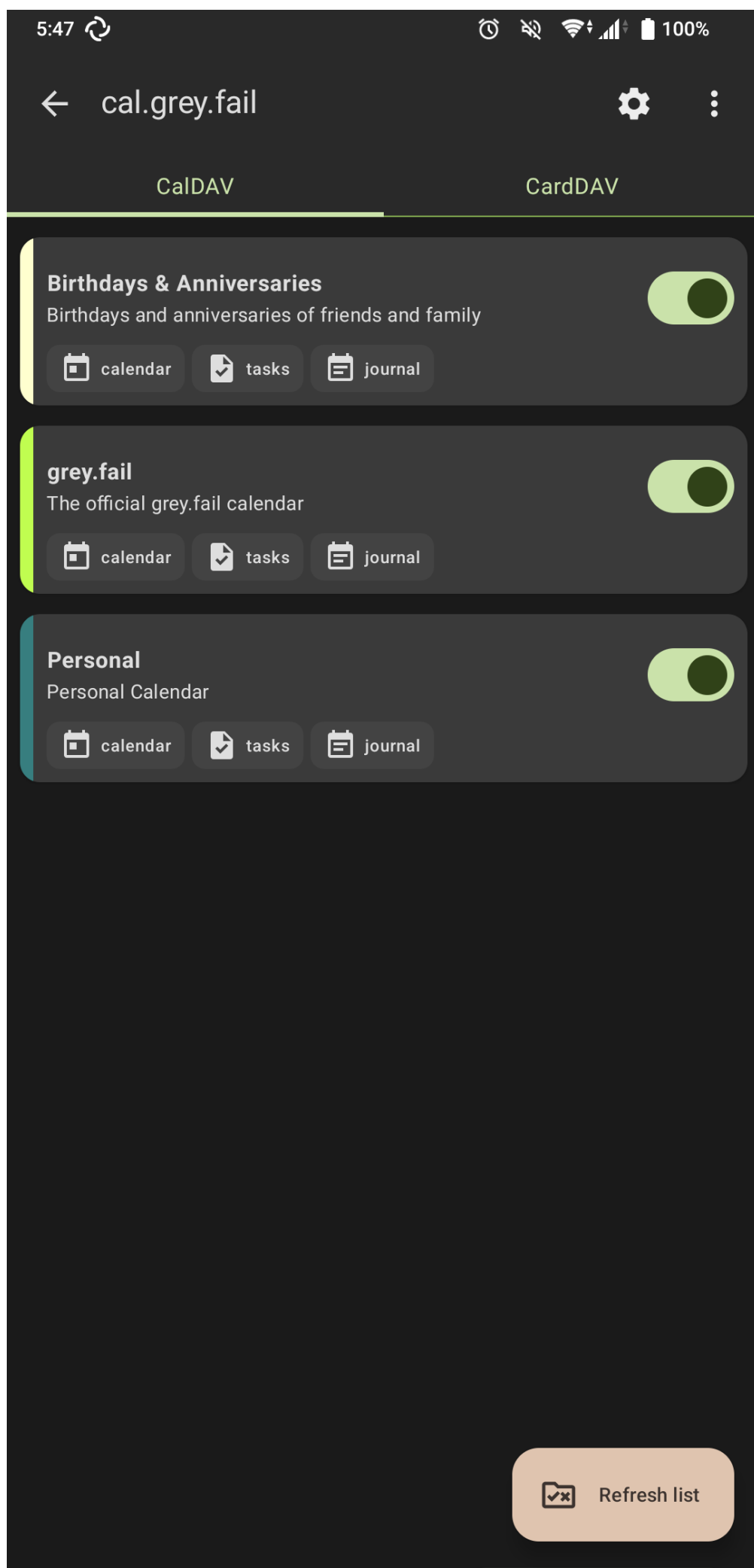
☒ Use your email address as account name because Android will use the account name as ORGANIZER field for events you create. You can't have two accounts with the same name.
